- ✓ ECTRI : international non-profit French association governed by statutes and cooperation agreement, 2003
- ✓ The cooperation agreement allows to have other partners in the projects supported by ECTRI and treats IPR common rules
- ✓ For countries where the surface transport research community is complex there is a M.O.U. to apply to ECTRI

✓ ECTRI is opened to new members from Eastern and Western Europe

✓ Incentive for Eastern Countries: 1000 Euros

✓ Western Countries: 10 000 Euros



6- Membership criteria

- ✓ To commit to the ECTRI statutes both in English and French versions
- ✓ To commit to the ECTRI cooperation agreement
- ✓ To commit to the ECTRI fees level
- ✓ To be carrying out surface transport research at least in two modes
- ✓ To be national transport research institute; if there is no official national transport research institute, the applicant has to be a national hub of transport research teams in its country at the academic level (M.O.U.)

8.1. Strategic paper

- **Common position** of all ECTRI members that are both competitors and cooperators :
 - Long term vision and missions of ECTRI
 - ECTRI contribution to European Research Area and to FRDPs
 - ECTRI focus on sustainable European Transport system of the future
- > Definition of 5 research areas :
 - Issues for a sustainable transport system
 - Intelligent transport system (ITS)
 - Traffic and transport safety and security
 - Behavioral and social aspects of traffic and transport
 - Transport economics
- Horizontal issue : priorities are approached in a multidisciplinary and system approach way



8-ECTRI activities (3)

- Independent vision from the one of the stakeholders (industry, policy makers and service providers, users, consumers, scientific community, public and private research funding) which concerns the stakeholders themselves as well as all European or National Institutions
- Facilitation of the preparation of the **new generation of** transport related **scientists and professionals**
- Having a research infrastructure at an International level using both hard and soft research facilities
- **Cooperation forms**:
 - « Clearing house »
 - Connecting professionals
 - Communities of practice
 - Ad hoc cooperation in projects
 - Structured cooperation in projects
 - Structured integration of Networks of Excellence
- > Basic idea: achieving an effective European Transport policy through the creation of a European virtual Transport Research Institute

8.3. Young Researchers Seminars

- This is a work on mobility in order to help to the creation of a new generation of researchers (FERSI joins ECTRI)
- Aims: to train young researchers to have excellent oral and written presentation through a strong multicultural european tutorial

(1 tutor for 3 young researchers and 2 tutors per session)



- ➤ The **first Young Researchers Seminar** organized by ECTRI and FERSI was from 16 to 18 December 2003
- > **Themes** of 2003 seminar :
 - Environmental issues
 - Economical issues
 - Safety issues
 - Sustainability
- > An **award** is given to the best presentation
- The **next one** is in preparation for **end 2004 beginning 2005** (ECTRI, FERSI and FEHRL would join)
