

**1. The innovation production issue:** Continued fragmentation of research ; “silo” forming, instead of integration; lack of long term vision. H2020 addresses primarily short term whereas research needs about 10 years to produce results: *need more long term vision / consistent and coherent*

**4. ECTRI proposes** (July 2014 paper for H2020) 5 main research areas (WP 2016 and beyond):

**(I) Individual users’ mobility behaviour**

**(II) Multimodal mobility systems and services**

**(III) Advanced logistic services**

**(IV) Resilient and secure transport systems**

**(V) Research support for decision-making**

**2. The research content focus issue:** Still focusing on addressing the problems through transport means (automobile / rail / aviation) and *less* the transport system.  
*Need more integration and long term vision*

**3. Need for more emphasis towards:**

- ❖ Economy / improving competitiveness;
- ❖ “Social aspects” (users’ needs, acceptance, accessibility for all users);
- ❖ Behavioural aspects;
- ❖ Equity issues, central vs periphery / rural regions.
